BLACK STUDENT DEMANDS

Black Studies program developed and created by Black students, in which to determine the selection of instructors, formulate the curriculum, and in which we are eligible to receive a degree in upon completion.

RAAF consulted before all Black administrators and faculty are hired.

A Black Cultural Affairs Center, with funds independent of ASUU.

We as students demand the right to use all facilities for cultural, educational, and entertainment purposes.

College administrators apply pressure to the Board of Realtors, Chamber of Commerce, etc., enforcing fair housing in Salt Lake City.

All students who are at a specific income level will have fees, books, and tuition waived.

Black students will take no General Education courses.

The University administration will take a stand supporting the freeing of Black Political prisoners in this country (Angela Davis, Ruchell Magee, etc.)

Black students shall receive either a salary or course credit for the development of the above-mentioned Black Studies Program.

A Black newspaper or newsletter designed with Blacks in mind (meaning no censorship).

We want our Black Counselor to have direct access and responsibility to no one but the President. We want him to have complete and exclusive power to make all decisions involving Black students without the consent of the administration. He should have access to all monies for Black students and ability to create his own budget for his office.

Development of an autonomous Black University Community in which Blacks are able to deal with Blacks in such areas as financial aid, scholarships, admittance, personnel, housing, counseling, student affairs, graduation, etc.

BLACK STUDENT DEMANDS

Amnesty for all faculty, administration, and students who have participated in the programs to implement the requested changes.

THESE DEMANDS WILL BE MET NO LONGER THAN FIVE DAYS AFTER THE DELIVERY OF THIS DOCUMENT, OR THE NECESSARY ACTIONS WILL BE TAKEN.
